Video Transcript: Flood Safety

[Narrator] This video could save your life. Floods are a major cause of death from natural hazards in Australia. They can be devastating, and you could be at risk even if you've never seen floodwaters near your home.

To help keep yourself and your family safe, plan ahead and be prepared before a flood happens with these three simple steps:

One: Make a flood plan and prepare an emergency kit with a battery-operated radio, a

torch, spare batteries and a first aid kit.

Two: If flooding is likely, keep informed. Monitor the Emergency WA website, DFES

Facebook, Twitter, 13 DFES and local radio for flood warnings. And

Three: if you're going to relocate to a safer place, leave early before water levels rise. Never

drive through floodwaters.

Staying safe in a flood is simple, but you must plan ahead with these simple steps:

One: Pack an emergency kit; Two: Keep informed; And

Three: Leave early and never drive through floodwaters.
