[Career firefighter Henry] Hey guys, welcome to the new. Vincent Fire Station, Carr Street, West Perth. I'm firefighter Henry,

I'm firefighter Korica, we'll show you around.

[Firefighter Henry] Oh, how are you going? As firefighters you know we have to remain fit and strong, so for that we need unique specialised equipment and, here, is where the magic happens. And here is one of the magicians himself, working on - hey, how you going Deano? You struggling a bit? Alright buddy, only 30 to go. Let's go, 29, [Grunts] 30. You'll get there!

Hey guys, as firefighters, a major part of our role includes training, and Vincent Fire Station has been built to accommodate over 18 firefighters. They're doing a bit of training now. We'll go and check out what they're doin'. What are we doing today guys?

[Firefighter Korica] Bit of casualty care.

From here we've got a great view of the city that we're here to protect. All the way from William Street back to the freeway. We respond to anything from structure fires to HAZMAT and road crash rescue. The opening of Vincent Fire Station has meant that we can now support the high workload of Perth Fire Station.

[Firefighter Henry] And of course one of the most important parts of the fire station is the engine bay. Vincent Fire Station can hold up to six appliances. Let me show you now.

[Over PA] Perth first, Perth second, turn out to a call received by triple zero, to a report of a house fire.

[Firefighter Korica] Remember: if you see us out with lights and sirens, don't panic, move to the left if it's safe to do so.
